### **Public invited to expand knowledge at Waterford with two F/M Communiversality classes**

#### **Angel of the Prairie: The Story of Herman Stern, Saturdays, March 21 and 28, 2 to 4 p.m.**

Terry Shoptaugh, PhD, archivist and professor at Minnesota State University Moorhead, will present this class, which is partially funded by the North Dakota Humanities Council. The class will focus on the life of Herman Stern, who worked in the family clothing business, Straus Clothing. Sometimes called “North Dakota’s Schindler,” Stern rescued more than 100 German Jews in the 1930s and ’40s. Some of the people he saved made North Dakota their home; their experiences will be shared in this class.

#### **Women of Mystery in Fiction and Film, Saturdays, April 4, 18 and 25, 2 to 4 p.m.**

Mitzi Brunsdale, PhD, professor of English at Mayville State University, will present this class, which examines three famous female detectives: Nancy Drew, Jessica Fletcher and Miss Marple. Each session will include an overview of their creators’ lives and works and a film performance of one of their famous cases.

F/M Communiversality is presented by Concordia College and is offered at several locations throughout Fargo-Moorhead.
